











Demographic Distribution of Students/ International Students/Staff
















International Exchange Activities

So as to fulfill its vision to "Accentuate worldwide connections", UKK seeks to promote international academic and student exchange activities by partnering with overseas academic institutions.

Through the years, the University had developed a wide range of international exchange programs, including regular student exchanges, official faculty exchanges, and international joint research projects.

As of May 1st, 2023, UKK had established institutional partnership agreements with 20 different countries and regions.

Student-Friendly Living Environment

★Low cost of living (Estimated Monthly Fee)

1. One-room apartment, 2-5min walk from School (UKK installs many households appliances such as refrigerator, washing machine, microwave oven, bed, etc..

 $JPY24,000\sim28,000/m$

2. No Commuting Expenses $\underline{\underline{\mathbf{Y}}}$ 0-

3. Electricity, Water and Gas JPY10,000~15,000/m

4. Health Insurance Fee* JPY1,700/m

(Annual Insurance Fee is about ¥20,000. About 90% of that is covered by the Supporter's Association in UKK.)

★One of the lowest costs of living Among major Japanese cities for housing, food and other expenditures.

★Easy access to the centre of Kitakyushu, 10 minute monorail ride (JPY250/1way).
